


Baby Carriage Embroidery Pattern and Instructions

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Stitching Instructions

Backstitch the baby carriage outline in dark pink

Stitch scalloped carriage edges in light pink.

Outline the scallops on the carriage in light pink.

Stitch the flowers on the carriage in dark pink with yellow French knots in each flower center. (see lazy daisy instructions below)

Stitch eight spokes in each wheel with silver floss making sure to space them evenly.

Stitch the wheels in gray. Bring the needle up for the first stitch, count forward six and stitch down. Count forward one and stitch up. Count back six and stitch down. Count forward one and stitch up, etc. Work your way around the wheel until all holes have two stitches in them.


Stitch the handle in silver. Stitch up where indicated, count forward three and stitch down. Continue to the end of the handle.

Stitch the border scallops in either light or dark pink.

Lazy Daisy:

Punch holes in each flower as shown by the black dots in the enlarged diagram to the right.

To stitch a daisy petal, bring the needle up at the center hole. Pull all of the thread through and then pass the needle back down through the same hole, leaving a loop on the top side of the card. Bring the needle up through one of the holes at the tip of a petal and catch the loop from step one with your needle. Stitch down in the same hole (see illustration)



Repeat for each petal. Stitch a yellow French knot in the center of each flower *Note: Stitch 1 and 2 are both done in the center hole. Stitches 3 and 4 are both done in the hole at the tip of the petal*

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
