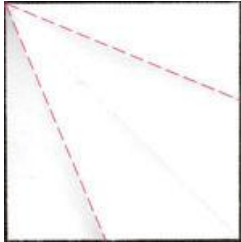


Seven Point Star

Teabag Folding Instructions

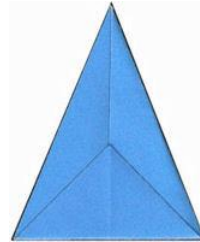
Red dashes signify valley folds.



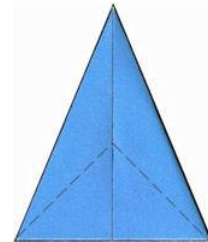
Begin by making a kite fold.



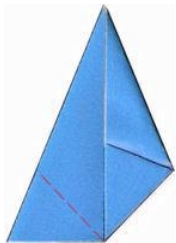
Fold the wide point up as indicated by the red dashed line.



Your tile should look like this.



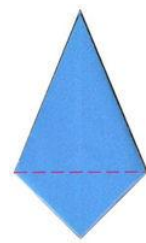
Tuck the bottom flap under the side flaps.



Fold the bottom corners to the center as indicated.



Your tile should look like this.

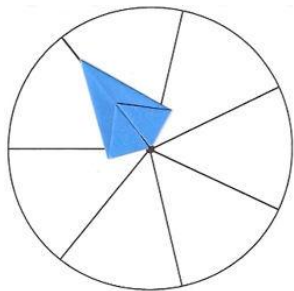


Turn the tile over and fold the bottom point up as indicated by the red dashed line.

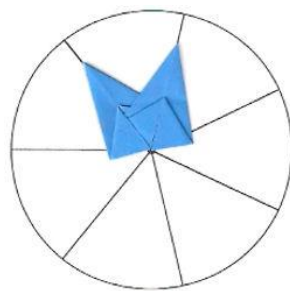


Your finished tile should look like this.

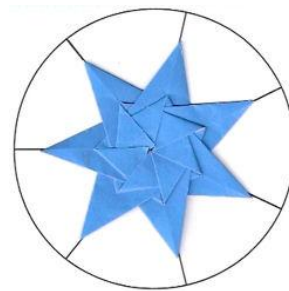
Assembling the Star



Use the positioning template on the next page to assemble your star. Place the center of the wide point on the dot in the center of the template. Align the center of the narrow point with one of the spokes as shown.



Add another tile to the right of the first one. Slide the left side of the new tile under the center flap of the left tile. Make sure that the center of the wide point on the new tile is positioned over the center dot on the template and the narrow point of the new tile is aligned with a spoke as shown.

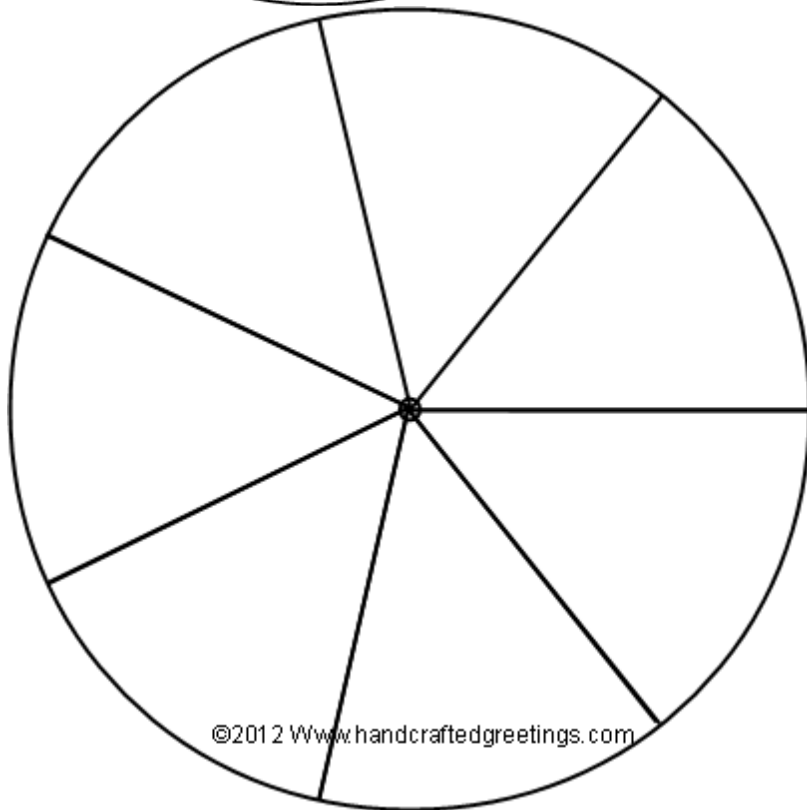
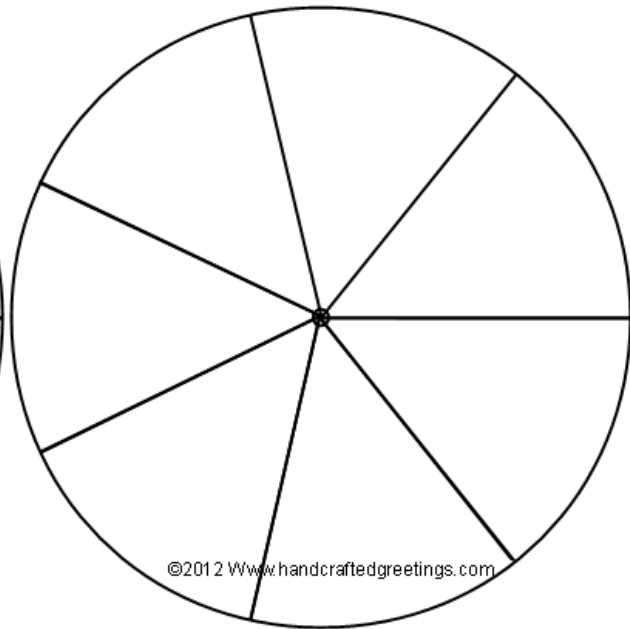
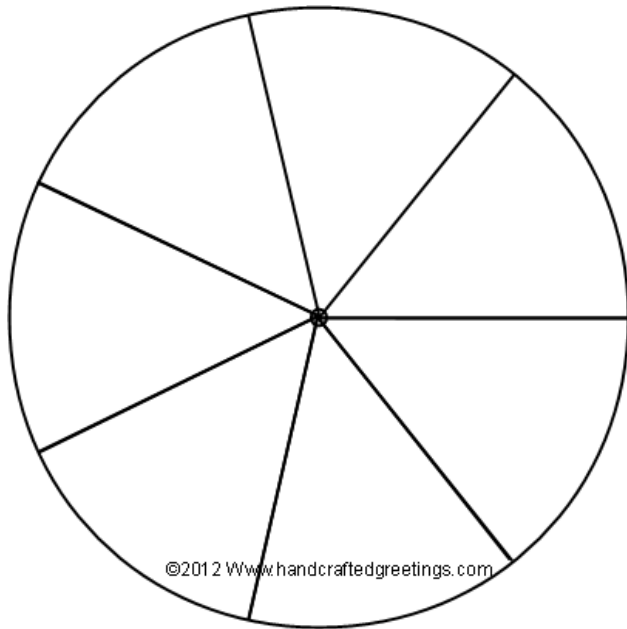


Continue adding the remaining tiles, using the positioning template as a guide.
