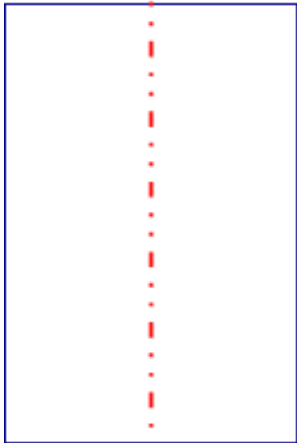


# Snowflake – Rectangle Tile

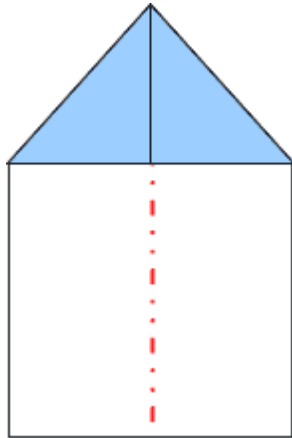
## Teabag Folding Instructions

Red dashes signify valley folds, blue dashes signify mountain folds.

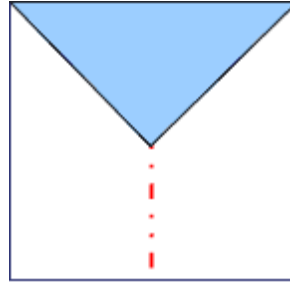
Use a rectangle with a height that is between 1.3 and 1.5 times the width.



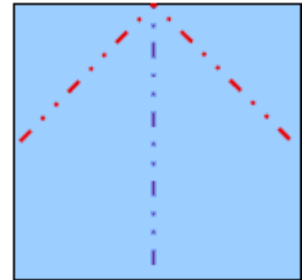
Begin by folding the tile in half lengthwise.



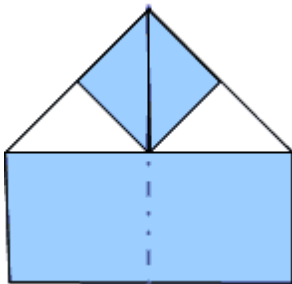
Fold the top right and left corners down to the center.



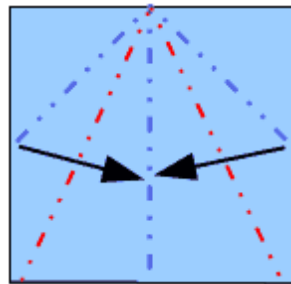
Fold the top point down.



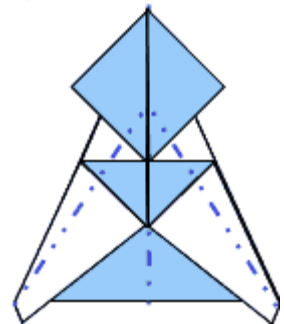
Fold the top right and left corners down to the center again.



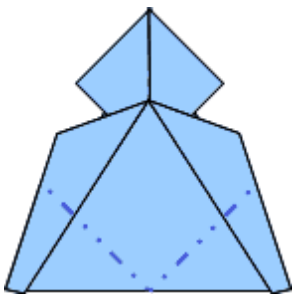
Your tile should look like this.



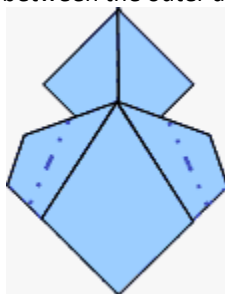
Unfold the folds from the previous step. On the top layer only, reverse the outer valley folds into mountain folds. Bring outer folds to center fold line, creating a valley fold between the outer and center mountain folds.



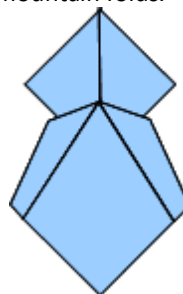
Your tile should look like this. Fold inside edges up and out as indicated by the blue dotted line.



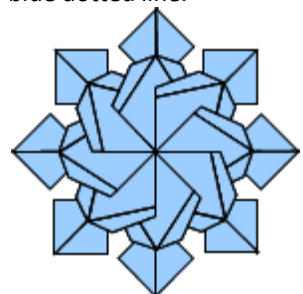
Fold the lower left and right corners under.



Fold the left and right edges under.



Your completed tile should look like this.
